Leaves Motor Activity

Motor Activity (Virtual)

1. Follow the Movements on the Autumn Cards
2. Rip a piece of paper into tiny pieces, crumble all of the pieces of paper into small balls, Using your index finger and thumb flick the small balls of paper onto a target (another piece of paper)

Motor Activity (In Person)

1. Using a white piece of computer paper, fold in half. Color one half of the paper brown, color the other half of the paper red. Using a second piece of computer paper, fold in half. Color one half of the paper orange or yellow, color the second half of the paper green.
2. Rip up the 2 pieces of paper into hand sized pieces. Loosely crumble the pieces of paper into a ball – creating fallen leaves.
3. Using the eraser end of a pencil, hit fallen leaves as fast as you can from one end of your mat to the other.
4. **OR** - Maintain downward dog pose, Crawl out and pick up one piece of paper and bring it to your feet, Repeat until all of the pieces of paper are by your feet
